#### Appendix 2 – Schedule of Penalties and Who May Apply Them

##### 7. Penalty Definitions Restrictions and Conditions

7.7. **Disqualification:** a penalty imposed in writing by the relevant Judicial body disqualifying the Competitor from the relevant Event or part of an Event and its results and prizes and awards. Disqualification can only be imposed by the Clerk of the Course, Stewards of the Event, Championship Stewards (Art.4.1 above applies) or the National Court. This penalty may be imposed retrospectively by the National Court.

7.7.1. A penalty of **Disqualification** against a driver in a multi-driver entry in Circuit Racing will result in the **Disqualification** of the whole entry.

#### Chapter 12 – Race

#### Appendix 12 – Competitor Regulations

##### 2. During the Competition:

2.3 A **Driver** may drive only one **Vehicle** with the exception of i and ii below. Not more than one **Driver** may drive the same **Vehicle** in any one **Race** unless the **Official Documents** specify otherwise (**Ch.2, App.2, Art. 7.7.1. applies**).

- i. the provisions relating to Endurance Racing.
- ii. races of 40 minutes or more that provide for driver changes where a driver may drive a maximum of 2 Vehicles during the Event provided they are properly entered and qualified in each Vehicle. The Official Documents will need to clearly define the eligibility of Championship Points.

**Date of Implementation: 1<sup>st</sup> January 2027**

**Reason:** Race Committee were tasked with considering whether any regulatory change is needed in respect of a penalty of Disqualification imposed on a driver who is participating in an Event as part of a multi-driver entry.

Following extensive discussion the Committee agreed that the whole entry should be disqualified.

This is referred to Judicial Committee for consideration as this will also impact Karting for example and may impact other disciplines.

Additionally if a driver is disqualified for a breach that incurs licence penalty points – should the whole entry receive 6 licence penalty points.
